Over the past quarter century, Elli Milan has been making her mark on the art scene. She began her art education at the Savannah College of Art and Design and graduated from the Lamar Dodd School of Art at the University of Georgia. It was during her college years that she received a vision of her future life as an artist and art mentor in the New Art Renaissance of the 21st century. Since then, she has worked steadily to live out that vision.

Elli began her professional art career in 1996. Since that time, she has worked in the traditional and the decorative art markets and has sold over 10,000 canvases which now hang in homes, galleries, and offices around the world. In 2010, she moved one step closer to realizing her vision when she opened the Milan Art Institute. Since the inception of the art school, Elli has taught thousands of students how to become professional artists in their own right.



Elli's artwork is distinguished by bold marks and contrast, as well as jewel-toned colors and the appearance of light. Many of her works look as if they are glowing from within. The boldness of her process combined with the use of symbolic imagery and the juicy richness of the oil paint create art that exudes spirituality and the ethereal.


What I really want people to come away with when they see my artwork is I want them to feel like they went into another world.[...] I also want people to feel empowered when they see my artwork and know that anything is possible and that dreams are worth dreaming. If we believe, we can achieve anything we set our heart to.

She currently lives in Statham, Georgia on the campus of Milan Art. Her days are divided between creating canvases, hosting the Milan Art podcast, speaking at events and doing artistic outreach in the local community and beyond. In the future, Elli would like to establish a permanent art studio in Greece. There, she hopes to honor her Greek heritage and to inspire up-and-coming art students to continue their own journeys, set against the backdrop of one of the greatest art cultures in history.

As the daughter of two professional artists, painting began as a hobby for Dimitra Milan Dunn at the age of twelve. She turned professional by the time she was 15, retailing a million dollars in art sales during her first year as a professional artist. At 17, she stepped into the role of art instructor at the Milan Art Institute. Now, in her early 20's, she is one of the co-owners of Milan Art.

Dimitra's passion for painting emerged when she began selling her paintings. She realized that her work affected people on an emotional level. This realization motivated her to take the portfolio classes at the Milan Art Institute. From this experience - which she calls a kind of artistic bootcamp - her unique style emerged. Her artwork typically features women and animals together in a dreamlike and romantic style that has attracted art collectors across the globe.



I hope that when people see my artwork, they see beauty. I hope that they see themselves. I hope they have some kind of deep, internal response in their heart-not just a cognitive response. I want the paintings to be like a door to a new world, a heavenly realm where there are no prey and there are no predators, just beauty, hope, adventure, confidence, and of course love.



In addition to being a painter, Dimitra wears the hat of poet, TV show and podcast host, and inspirational speaker. This coming summer, she'll return to Greece to paint with a couple of groups of Milan Art students and to film Season 3 of Milan Art's reality TV show The Outstanding Artist. Having this season's TV show filmed in her ancestral homeland of Greece feels especially significant to her.
